

Here is an update of where your calves should be at the beginning of this new year!

Steers

We have found using the winter months to your advantage is essential. Steers should be receiving at least 15 lbs of grain every 24 hours. Make sure they have free choice grass hay at all times.

For Both Steers & Heifers

We recommend you worm your calves as soon as possible. This will help increase your feed efficiency & help your calf reach its full potential.

It is never too early to work your calves. You should tie them up and walk them twice a week. Start now to teach your calves how to use the show stick and lead in a show ring. For best results, tie your calf out side of the pen, they will learn to lead much faster that way.

Heifers

Be careful not to get your heifers too fat, it can affect reproduction. Heifers need no more than 10 lbs of grain and free choice grass hay.

If you have not Lutalysed your heifer it should be done as soon as possible. Our cattle are early maturing and the bulls were with them all summer.
